

## PROCEEDINGS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF MYSORE

**Sub:-** Accord sanction to the award of Government of India Post-matric scholarships to the students belonging to Nomadic and Semi-nomadic Tribes throughout the State.

**Read:-** 1) No. PHS 106 SAD 63, dated 24<sup>th</sup> June 1965  
2) Letter No. DSW/CS-185/65, dated 11<sup>th</sup> October, 1965 from the Director of Social Welfare in Mysore, Bangalore.

### Preamble:-

In Government Order dated 24<sup>th</sup> June 1965 read above, approval was accorded to the inclusion of the communities known as "Dombidasa" and "Bailapatar" in the list of Nomadic and Semi-Nomadic Tribes.

The Director of Social Welfare States that at present there is no uniform list of Nomadic and Semi-Nomadic Tribes applicable to the entire State unlike the list of 56 communities which are recognised as Nomadic and Semi-Nomadic Tribes in the Bombay Karnataka area and that the various facilities contemplated under the Plan scheme for the welfare of Nomadic and Semi-Nomadic Tribes have to be extended to the entire State. But under the Government of India Post-matric scholarship Scheme, the awards are confined to the students of Nomadic and Semi-Nomadic Tribes in the Bombay area only. As such, deserving students in other areas of the State studying Post-matric courses are not getting scholarships though special concession is extended under the Government of India Scholarship Scheme.

In the circumstances, the Director of Social Welfare has requested to agree to the extension of the concession of award of Government of India Post-matric scholarships to the students of Nomadic and Semi-Nomadic Tribes in the entire State and sent a list.
